Mission:

The mission of Any Baby Can is to serve families with children and youth facing serious health or developmental challenges.

2021 Impact:

Caring for a child or youth with special healthcare needs is difficult. Finding help shouldn't be. In 2021, any baby can offered support to...

- 3,800+ individuals were helped through our Comprehensive Family Support Services.
- 200+ different diagnoses served in our Case Management Program.
- 8,000+ home visits/video calls between Case Managers and families through the Case Management Program. Connections made were 1:1 personalized help for each child's unique needs.
- \$2,030,000 of medication services provided through our Prescription Assistance Program
- 545 individuals were served by our Center for Infant & Child Loss
- \$50,027.28 was spent on funeral assistance through our Center for Infant & Child Loss – the only resource in our community offering this type of wide-ranging support for parents and caregivers.
- Advocated and assisted in the introduction of HB 2134 in the Texas House, which would make cranial helmets for babies more accessible for families.

2021 Autism Support Program Impact:

- 47% of our clients were diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder
- 249 parents attended presentations by our Autism Services Program staff to learn how to identify and understand behaviors in their child or youth with autism spectrum disorder.
- 308 educators, first responders, and other community members were trained on autism awareness, behavior strategies, and safety awareness.
- 100+ San Antonio Police Department cadets trained about inclusion and understanding of people on the autism spectrum.
